The regular City Council meeting will be held **Thursday, July 16, at 7:00 p.m.** at Town Hall. Agenda items include continued discussion of the proposed Parker County Public Utility Agency and consideration of the **Mayor's Monarch Pledge Proclamation**.

Mayor Roberts is passionate about supporting monarch butterflies and their annual migration to Mexico. The Town serves as a Monarch Waystation, and each October she hosts a community event featuring milkweed seeds to help create habitat and provide food for these beautiful pollinators.
