Wastewater Treatment Plant Odors

From time to time, residents may notice odors associated with the Town’s Wastewater Treatment Plant. These odors are a normal part of the treatment process and can become more noticeable due to weather conditions, rainfall, temperature changes, and other environmental factors.

The treatment process relies on naturally occurring biological activity and requires ongoing adjustments to maintain optimal performance. Town staff continuously monitor and manage the system, and the facility remains in compliance with all applicable requirements of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).
