



PUBLIC WORKS REPORT September 2025

WATER: In the month of September 2025, the water system met the standards and rules of TCEQ. The contractors that are installing fiber optics in our town slowed down significantly, halfway through the month. At the end of September, the crew completed the drilling process and moved into pulling the fiber. This has been a welcome change. While the number of utilities damaged by the crews did not completely end, but they slowed down by the end of the month. ATT will have another phase of construction in the future, but the start date is yet to be stated. Lead and copper sampling were completed for the Learners water system. The next round of lead and copper sampling will not be done until 2027 for the Deer Creek and Lakes of Aledo water systems and 2028 for the Learners system. The water supply continued to keep up with the demand in September.
