



## Weekly Report – December 12, 2025

- We are thrilled to announce that security cameras have been successfully installed at Stuard Elementary and Annetta Elementary this week. This project was fully funded through the Annetta Crime Control and Prevention District funds, demonstrating a strong commitment to enhancing safety in our schools.

Our team has been working closely with Aledo ISD for over a year to bring this project to life, and we are grateful for the continued support of Mayor Roberts, who has been a passionate advocate for getting this project across the finish line.

These installations are a significant step in ensuring a safer learning environment for all students and staff, and we look forward to continuing our work with the community to prioritize safety in Annetta's schools.




- We want to update the community on the status of the Town's water tower SCADA system following the lightning strike on November 23, which caused significant damage. Our operations team has been actively monitoring the water system using a temporary setup, ensuring continued service and responsiveness.

The installation of the new, fully upgraded system began this week, with completion expected by the end of the year. During this time, water pressure may fluctuate slightly, but please rest assured that we are working diligently to minimize any disruptions.

- We are pleased to inform the community that we have secured a company to replace the rope on the Town's flagpole. This repair is scheduled to take place in the near future, ensuring that our flag will once again be properly displayed.
- Just a reminder that Winter Sewer Averaging began on November 25<sup>th</sup>. The months December, January, and February will be used to calculate your average water consumption, which typically reflects household consumption without the impact of outdoor irrigation.
- The Town's logo is scheduled to be added to the Rainwater Harvesting Ground Storage Tank. The work will begin as soon as the temperatures are suitable for painting. This addition will further enhance the visibility and branding of the Town's efforts in sustainability and water conservation.
- We are pleased to announce that we will be adding railing along the wheelchair ramp and stairs to Town Hall to improve accessibility for citizens with disabilities. This enhancement will provide additional support for those who may need assistance when visiting Town Hall. We are committed to making our facilities as accessible as possible for all members of the community.
- The City Council will meet next Thursday, December 18, at 7:00 p.m. at Annetta Town Hall. We invite you to attend and be part of the discussion.

During the meeting, Mayor Roberts and the City Council will honor Rolf and Gay Larson for their outstanding volunteer contributions to the Town. In recognition of their efforts, the Parker County Master Gardeners have generously donated two oak trees in their honor. These trees have been planted near the entry to Town Hall as a lasting tribute to their dedication.
