💧 Stage 1 Voluntary Water Restrictions Remain in Effect

The Town remains under **Stage 1 voluntary water restrictions through September 30**. Water demand continues to be extremely high, particularly **overnight and on weekends due to irrigation use**.

We need everyone's cooperation. Please reduce outdoor watering, avoid watering every day, and limit irrigation systems to **2–3 days per week** whenever possible.

While restrictions remain voluntary at this time, **continued high demand could result in mandatory water restrictions**. Please conserve now to help reduce demand on our water system and protect our community's water supply.

💧 Rainwater Harvesting Project

We are excited that the **Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District** has installed an educational sign highlighting the Town's rainwater harvesting system! This system was made possible through a grant awarded to the Town and captures rainwater for beneficial reuse.

Collected rainwater is used to **irrigate trees on Town property** and for **cleaning at the Wastewater Treatment Plant**, helping conserve our valuable groundwater resources.
