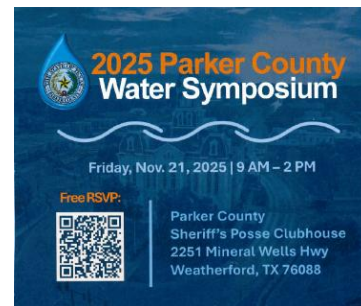
Cast your vote here:
