- We hope everyone made it safely through the winter storm. While we experienced extreme cold temperatures, we were thankful for the minimal loss of power. The Town office was closed for a portion of the week; however, office staff worked remotely, and the Town’s operators worked throughout the storm to ensure water and sewer services continued to operate as effectively as possible. The Town office follows Aldeo ISD closures during these times.

Please continue to take precautions to protect people, pets, pipes and plants.

- Be on the lookout for your water bill, which was mailed today. We hope you receive it in a timely manner; however, delivery may be delayed due to weather and road conditions, as the postal service may be running behind.

- Just a reminder that Winter Sewer Averaging began on November 25th. The months December, January, and February will be used to calculate your average water consumption, which typically reflects household consumption without the impact of outdoor irrigation.
- The Town’s annual Clean Up & Beatification Day is scheduled for Saturday, February 28, from 9:00 a.m. until noon. Lunch will be provided for volunteers. Please come out, meet your neighbors, and help keep our Town clean.
