Special City Council Meeting Minutes

The City Council met in a specially scheduled meeting on Monday, May 11, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. in the Annetta Town Hall at 450 Thunder Head Lane to consider the following agenda:

- I. **Call to order.** Mayor Sandy Roberts called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- II. **Pledge of Allegiance/Invocation of Prayer.** Council Member Brandon Thompson led the pledge and Council Member Jim Causey gave the invocation.
- III. **Roll call/Quorum check.** A quorum check showed that Mayor Roberts and Council Members, Jim Causey, Kent Stasey, and Brandon Thompson were present. Council Member Danny Coffman was absent, and Council Member Place 1 is currently vacant. Also present was Jamee Long, City Secretary/Administrator.
- IV. **Public Comments:** There were no public comments.
- V. **New Business:**

- a. **Discussion and Action:** Canvass the results of the May 2nd Special Election and consider resolution declaring the results.

The City Council canvassed the election results. Council Member Stasey moved to approve the resolution declaring the election results, and Council Member Causey seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

- b. **Administer Oaths of Office of Council Members 2 and 4.**

Mayor Roberts administered the oath of office to Council Member Jim Causey. Council Member Coffman will be sworn in at a later date.

- VI. **Items of Community Interest.**


Council Member Causey discussed the future game for Aledo Boys Baseball.
