Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting Minutes

The Town of Annetta Planning and Zoning Commission met on Thursday, August 8, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in the Annetta Town Hall at 450 Thunder Head Lane.

I. Statement of Rules of Proceedings:

The rules for the conduct of tonight's meeting are to ensure fairness to all persons interested in speaking either about general planning matters or a specific item.

II. Call to order:

Traci Fambrough, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

III. Pledge of Allegiance/Invocation of Prayer.

Commissioners James Falconer led the pledge and Lee Ancona gave the invocation.

IV. Roll call/Quorum check.

Private wells can be registered on their website. Grants will be available for rain harvesting systems, they are open in October-February at the Upper Trinity Water Conservation office.

b. Update regarding minor plat of Lot 1, Block 1, Clearbrush Woods, more commonly known as 1200 Clearbrush Lane.
