💧 Stage 1 Voluntary Water Restrictions Remain in Effect

The Town remains under **Stage 1 voluntary water restrictions** through **September 30**. With the continued summer heat, water demand remains very high, particularly overnight and on weekends when many irrigation systems are running at the same time.

While the Town has **not yet reached the threshold for mandatory water restrictions**, we need everyone's cooperation to help keep it that way. Please reduce unnecessary outdoor watering, avoid running irrigation systems for extended periods, and be mindful of overall water use.

Stage 1 is voluntary, but conservation is important. Continued high demand could result in the Town moving to mandatory restrictions. Please do your part now to help reduce demand on our water system and ensure a reliable water supply for the entire community.
