Sales Tax Renewal – May 2, 2026 Election

The option to renew the Town of Annetta’s **one-quarter cent sales tax dedicated to street maintenance** will appear on the **May 2, 2026 Special Election** ballot.

This sales tax was originally approved by voters in **2014** and has been successfully renewed in **2018** and **2022**.

What does this mean:

- This tax currently funds **100% of street maintenance and improvements** in the Town
- If not renewed, these funds **may be redirected to another jurisdiction**


Ballot Information:


Voters will be asked to consider renewing the tax for an additional **four-year period**.

 Residents are encouraged to stay informed and participate in the upcoming election.

🏛️ The Planning & Zoning Commission and City Council have dedicated significant time over the past several months to reviewing the Town’s Zoning Ordinance and considering proposed amendments. These efforts have now reached a key milestone, and the proposed amendments are ready to be presented to the public.

Public hearings will be held on **May 14 (Planning & Zoning Commission)** and **May 21 (City Council)** at **7:00 p.m. at Town Hall**. Residents are encouraged to attend, stay informed, and participate in the governmental process. Following completion of the Zoning Ordinance amendments, the Town will begin workshops and a comprehensive review of the Town’s Comprehensive Plan.

💚 At the April 16 City Council meeting, Mayor Roberts issued proclamations recognizing **May as Mental Health Awareness Month** and **Water Safety Month**. These observances serve as important reminders to support the well-being and safety of our community.

Residents are encouraged to remain attentive to signs of mental health challenges and to offer support when needed. As summer approaches, please also exercise increased vigilance around water. Always supervise children closely near pools and other bodies of water, as accidents can occur in a matter of seconds.

🛠️ The Town’s annual summer road maintenance program will begin in June. Streets scheduled for resurfacing this year include **Wallis Road, Chapman Court, Royal Oak Drive, Shumard Drive, Portales Drive, and Meadow Glen Court**.

Parker County Precinct 4 will once again be performing this work. The Town greatly appreciates their continued partnership and the high level of service they provide to the residents of Annetta.
