

RESOLUTION NO. 19-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 4, 2019 SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE ANNETTA CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT SALES TAX FOR 20 YEARS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Annetta, Texas, is a Type A general law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, an election was duly held in the Town of Annetta on the 4th day of May, 2019 to consider a proposition to reauthorize the Annetta Crime Control and Prevention District sales tax for 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has met and canvassed the votes in such election; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said special election having been duly canvassed by the City Council, it is declared that the below propositions received the following votes:

PROPOSITION A

“Whether the Annetta Crime Control and Prevention District should be continued for 20 years and the crime control and prevention district sales tax should be continued for 20 years.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.


The City Council further finds that the results of the special election as set forth above are correct and the canvass of votes is hereby approved.
