



Weekly Report – December 5, 2025

- We hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving! The Christmas lights were installed on the Town Hall building this week, and they look beautiful.
- Due to the lightning strike on November 23 that damaged the Town's water tower SCADA system, our operators are still continuing to monitor the water system closely using a temporary setup. Installation of the new system will begin next week. Water pressure may continue to fluctuate slightly until the new system is fully installed.
- A reminder that Winter Sewer Averaging began November 25th. December, January, and February are the months used to calculate the water consumption average that determines your sewer rate for the new year.
- The Upper Trinity Groundwater Conservation District has added their logo to the Rainwater Harvesting Ground Storage Tank, and the Town plans to add our logo in the near future. We are excited to share that, thanks to recent rains, this tank is now nearly halfway full.
- On Wednesday, City Secretary/Administrator, Jamee Long presented a proclamation to the Zonta Club of Parker County, as adopted by the Annetta Mayor and City Council. The Zonta Club actively collaborates with community partners, hosts educational programs, supports scholarships, and advocates for policies that advance gender equality and protect human rights. We appreciate everything they are doing for our community.
