💧 Reminder that Stage 1 voluntary water restrictions are currently in effect through September 30 pursuant to the Town's Drought Contingency Plan. The goal of Stage 1 is to encourage voluntary conservation and raise awareness regarding potential drought conditions. Thank you for helping preserve our most valuable natural resource — water.

🚜💧 It's mowing season, so please do not mow over or damage the Town's water meters. Water meters and meter boxes can be expensive to repair or replace, and damage may result in charges to the property owner. Please use caution when mowing or weed eating around meter boxes and help keep the area accessible to Town staff. Thank you for helping protect the Town's utility infrastructure.

📦🔒 Just a reminder that the Town Hall parking lot includes an Internet Exchange Safe Zone parking spot. This designated area can be used for Marketplace and other online purchase exchanges. The project was funded by the Town's Crime Control and Prevention District in 2020.
