In the month of December, the water system operated in accordance with TECQ regulations. The New Scada system is still being implemented. A water main repair was made in the 100 block of Ridgecrest Dr. A service line repair was made in the 100 block of Royal Oaks Dr. Zenner our meter service provider, made a site visit to work through multiple reporting issues with our meters. On December 30th, the town experienced a power outage that affected our water plants, the backup generators preformed as they should, with the plants backup power switching over and returning to operation.

December 2025

In the month of December, the wastewater plant operated as normal and required no repairs. The pump in the lift station on Oakwood Dr. failed. The remaining pump was still in good operating order and no disruption in the collection system occurred. A new pump was ordered and replaced the pump that failed. One repair to a sewer collection line had to be made in the 100 block of Lakeview Dr. This sewer line was damaged by the boring crews, the line was damaged underneath a driveway. The approach of the driveway needed to be excavated and replaced to make the repair.
