Stage 1 Voluntary Water Restrictions Remain in Effect

The Town remains under **Stage 1 voluntary water restrictions** through **September 30**. Water demand has increased significantly in recent weeks, particularly overnight and on weekends, as irrigation systems are running for extended periods.

Although the Town has **not** reached the threshold for mandatory water restrictions, continued excessive outdoor watering could lead to additional conservation measures if demand continues to increase. We ask all residents to use water responsibly, limit unnecessary irrigation, and conserve wherever possible. Protecting our water supply is a community responsibility, and everyone's cooperation is appreciated.
