

RESOLUTION NO. 22-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 7, 2022 SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE TOWN OF ANNETTA AT THE RATE OF ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (1/4%) TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Annetta, Texas, is a Type A general law municipality located in Parker County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, an election was duly held in the Town of Annetta on the 7th day of May, 2022 to consider a proposition to reauthorize the local sales and use tax at the rate of a one-quarter percent (1/4%) to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has met and canvassed the votes in such election; and

WHEREAS, such canvass shows the following results:

AGAINST	<u>62</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the above canvass be and the same is hereby approved. The proposition submitted to the voters regarding the reauthorization of the local sales and use tax at the rate of a one-quarter percent (1/4%) to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets was approved. The language of the proposition is as follows:

THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE TOWN OF ANNETTA AT THE RATE OF ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (1/4%) TO CONTINUE PROVIDING REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS. THE TAX EXPIRES ON THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DATE OF THIS ELECTION UNLESS THE IMPOSITION OF THE TAX IS REAUTHORIZED.


SECTION 2.
