Stage 1 Voluntary Water Restrictions Remain in Effect

The Town remains under Stage 1 voluntary water restrictions through September 30. Please continue to use water wisely and conserve whenever possible. Every drop helps protect our community's water supply.

Mayor's Monarch Pledge

City Council approved the Mayor's Monarch Pledge Proclamation, continuing Mayor Roberts' dedication to protecting Monarch butterflies. Town Hall is a certified Monarch Waystation, providing habitat for butterflies during their migration to Mexico. Watch for details about the Mayor's annual milkweed seed event this fall.

Pasture Mowed for Fire Safety

The pasture south of Town Hall has been mowed to help reduce tall vegetation and minimize potential fire hazards during the hot, dry summer months.
