

ORDINANCE NO. 100101

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA ESTABLISHING
REDUCED FEES FOR BUILDING, ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING AND
MECHANICAL PERMITS FOR CERTAIN GOVERNMENTAL
ENTITIES AND RELIGIOUS NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS;
PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to provide reduced fees for
governmental, non-profit and religious establishments while ensuring
safety within the Town; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA,
TEXAS:

Section 1: Notwithstanding requirements currently in force, the fees for building,
electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits for religious, non-profit and
governmental entities for new or expanded structures of less than five
thousand (5,000) square feet shall be the charges made to the City by its
Inspector(s) for examining and approving plans and inspecting the
improvements.

Section 2: All rights and remedies of the Town of Annetta are expressly saved as to
any and all violations of the provisions of any ordinances affecting health
and safety which have accrued at the time of the effective date of this
ordinance; and, as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation,
both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not, under such
ordinances, same shall not be affected by this ordinance, but may be
prosecuted until final disposition by the courts.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
