City Council Meeting Minutes

The City Council of Annetta met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, April 20, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the Annetta Town Hall at 450 Thunder Head Lane to consider the following agenda:

- I. Call to order. Mayor Bruce Pinckard called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Pledge of Allegiance/Invocation of Prayer. Councilman Shane Mudge led the pledge and Councilman Danny Coffman gave the invocation.
- III. Roll call/Quorum check. A quorum check revealed that Mayor Bruce Pinckard, Councilmembers Kent Stasey, Mark Wohl, Shane Mudge and Danny Coffman were all present. Councilmember Rico Remigio was not present. Also present, City Secretary, Jamee Long and Director of Operations and Planning, Dennis Thompson.
- IV. Public Comments: No public comments.
- V. Consent Items: Reports from City Staff and Commissions or Committees:
 - a. Consider the approval of Minutes from the Regular City Council Meeting on March 16, 2017.
 - **b. Financial Report.** Dennis Thompson, Director of Operations & Planning, presented the financial report to Council.
 - **c. Public Works Report.** Jamee Long, City Secretary, presented the public works report. Councilman Stasey moved to accept all consent items, Councilman Wohl seconded the motion, with all aye. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion passed unanimously.
- j. Discussion and Action: Consider authorizing the expenditure of up to \$5,000 for AEP Prime Oil, CRS2 Emulsion and Grade 4 topping rock for resurfacing Hollow Drive (Rim Rock to Branch Hollow Lane), Branch Hollow Lane to Rock Glen Court, Rock Glen Court (Branch Hollow Lane to Deer Creek Drive). Councilman Coffman moved to approve the expenditure of up to \$5,000 for AEP Prime Oil, CRS2 Emulsion and Grade 4 topping rock for resurfacing Hollow Drive (Rim Rock to Branch Hollow Lane), Branch Hollow Lane to Rock Glen Court, Rock Glen Court (Branch Hollow Lane to Deer Creek Drive), Councilman Mudge seconded the motion, with all aye. Motion passed unanimously.
- k. **Discussion and Action:** Consider authorizing the Mayor to execute an Award of Contract with Matrix Demolition, LLC in the amount of \$12,705 for demolition of old wastewater treatment plant. - a. **Discussion and Action:** Consider recommendation from Planning and Zoning Commission that an ordinance be enacted to prohibit all property owners from suffering, permitting or allowing upon any street or roadway or right-of-way including any culvert or bar ditch the growth of grass, weeds, brush or any plant which is not cultivated to grow to a height greater than 48 inches; trees and bushes that have limbs or branches at a height of less than eight feet or hinders or impairs driving by a motorist or obscures a motorist's or pedestrian's view of any street or causes of hazard; and, rubbish, junk, trash; or the accumulation of dirt, gravel or other fill that reasonable impedes storm water drainage and flow. No action taken.
- b. **Discussion:** Discussion recommendation from Planning and Zoning Commission concerning changes to Master Thoroughfare Plan for the Annetta Comprehensive Plan. No action taken.
