ORDINANCE 76

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2001, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 102:001 ET SEQ. Tex. LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA, TEXAS FOR THE YEAR 2001.

WHEREAS the City of Annetta, Texas, must comply with the requirements of the Texas Uniform Budget Law (Sec. 102.001) Local Government code and

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Annetta must adopt an annual budget and conduct the financial affairs of the City in strict conformance with said budget and

WHEREAS no expenditures of funds of the City of Annetta shall be made except in strict compliance with the adopted budget (Exhibit A) or in case of grave public necessity or emergency and

WHEREAS the budget appended here as Exhibit A, for the year beginning January I, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001, was duly presented to the City Council by the Mayor and a public hearing was ordered by the City Council. A public notice of said hearing was caused to be given by the City Council being published in the designated newspaper and public hearing was held according to said notice, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the appropriations for the year beginning January 1, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001, for the support of the general government of the City of Annetta, Texas, be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's 2001 budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit a:

SECTION 2. That the budget as shown in words and figures in Exhibit A, is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City's budget for the year beginning January 1, 2001, and ending December 31, 2001.

SECTION 3. That no transfer of funds from any City Bank Account or Fund, no Transaction agreed to, or any expenditure made from any budget line item without formal approval of the City Council. Budget amendments shall be made in a timely manner of every line item that exceeds its budgeted amount as recommended by the L.G.C.
