WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Annetta has determined that the fees, administrative guidelines and charges established in the Uniform Administrative Code, 1988 Edition, are applicable to the regulation, inspection, and permitting of buildings and structures in the Town of Annetta and that such guidelines and fees are reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS:

SECTION I

That the Uniform Administrative Code, 1988 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, is hereby adopted. A copy of Said Uniform Administrative Code is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for all purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION VII

The Town Secretary of the Town of Annetta, Texas is hereby directed to publish the caption, penalty clause, publication clause and effective date clause of this ordinance in the official newspaper of the Town of Annetta, as authorized by Section 53.011 of the Local Government Code.

SECTION I

That the Uniform Administrative Code, 1991: Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, is hereby adopted. A copy of Said Uniform Administrative Code is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for all purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION II

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the Town of Annetta, Texas, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION III

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Town Board of Aldermen that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the Board of Aldermen without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION IV

The Town Secretary of the Town of Annetta is hereby authorized to purchase copies of the Uniform Administrative Code which have been published in book or pamphlet form for general distribution among the public and the operative provisions of same as so published shall be admissible in evidence in all courts without further proof than the production thereof.

SECTION V

Any person, firm or corporation who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for all violations involving fire safety or public health and sanitation and shall be fined Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,00.00) for all other violations of this ordinance. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION VI

All rights and remedies of the Town of Annetta, Texas, are expressly saved as to any and all violations of the provisions of any ordinances affecting buildings which have accrued at the time of the effective date of this ordinance; and as to such accrued violations and all pending litigation, both civil and criminal, whether pending in court or not under such ordinances, same shall not be affected by this ordinance but may be prosecuted until final disposition by the court.

SECTION VII

The Town Secretary of the Town of Annetta, Texas is hereby directed to publish the caption, penalty clause, publication clause and effective date clause of this ordinance in the official newspaper of the Town of Annetta, as authorized by Section 53.011 of the Local Government Code.

MODIFICATION TO UNIFORM BUILDING CODES:

- 1. In addition to the exemptions cited in Section 301 (b) of the Uniform Building Code a construction inspection permit shall not be required for the following types of construction when the resident owner act as Owner/Contractor assuming responsibility for proper and safe construction for the work being done:
 - (1) Modifications to existing residential structures which are used as the principal dwelling.\
 - (2) Modifications to existing non-habitable detached out buildings located on the premises of the main dwelling.
 - (3) Construction of new non-habitable detached out buildings on the premises of the main dwelling.
- 2. Upon application a "No Inspection Required" type permit shall be issued to the resident owner acting as Owner/Contractor.
- 3. A fee of \$15.00 shall be assessed for a "No Inspection Required" permit to cover administrative costs.
- 4. Exemption from the inspection requirements of the Uniform Building Codes shall not be deemed to grant authorization for any work to be done in violation of the provisions of the technical codes or any other laws or ordinances of this jurisdiction.
