

RESOLUTION NO. 15-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE PRIMARY OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER AND THE SECONDARY OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Annetta, Texas is a Type A general law municipality located in Parker County and created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Section 52.004 Texas Local Government Code provides as soon as practicable after the beginning of each municipal year, the governing body of the municipality shall contract, as determined by ordinance or resolution, with a public newspaper of the municipality to be the municipality's official newspaper until another newspaper is selected;

WHEREAS, the local newspaper is only published weekly;

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that is necessary, in order to meet certain requirements of publishing notices and other Town documents that a secondary official public newspaper of the Town of Annetta be designated;

WHEREAS, notice of the agenda for this meeting, was given in accordance with law by posting the same at the place reserved and designated for notices of public meetings and public activities and prior to the adoption of this ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The Town of Annetta hereby designates the *Community News* to be the primary official newspaper of the Town and *The Fort Worth Star Telegram* as the secondary official newspaper of the Town. The Town shall publish in the primary official newspaper each ordinance, notice or other matter required by law or ordinance to be published if time permits. The Town of Annetta may, in addition to publishing notice in the primary official newspaper, may publish notice in any other newspaper of general circulation within Parker County including *The Fort Worth Star Telegram*.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the Town of Annetta, Texas, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Town Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Town Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of its passage.
